



SASKATCHEWAN POST-FARM FOOD SAFETY PROGRAM



Eligibility:

- Non-federally registered processing plants that process ingredients/food for human consumption (exempting fish and seafood).
- For equipment, the processor must be currently undertaking or have completed development and implementation of a VR, HACCP or ISO 22000 program between April 1, 2009, and December 31, 2012.
- Work must be completed and/or equipment purchased from April 1, 2009, to December 31, 2012.
- Applicant must be in operation on date claim is being made.
- Funding is provided on a first-come first-served basis. Early application is recommended.
- Maximum: \$30,400 per processor.
- Minimum payment \$50 per application.
- Invoices for reimbursement must clearly indicate the service provided and/or equipment purchased.
- Processors must contribute a minimum of 50 per cent of eligible costs.

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- practices needed to meet the desired food safety standard;
 - An assessment report; and
 - Consultant's quote to complete the development of the food safety program.

Funding will be provided on a 50:50 cost-shared basis to a maximum of \$1,200 per processor. Eligible costs include third-party consultant fees and consultant expenses.

completed development and implementation of a VR, HACCP or ISO 22000 program between April 1, 2009, and December 31, 2012, to be eligible for funding.
