Post Farm Food Safety

- Financial support for non-federally registered processors to implement food safety systems i.e. HACCP, ISO 22000, Vendor Recognition program
- Targeted at processors of ingredients and food for human consumption (exempting fish)
- \$668,000 over 4 years
- Primary outcomes:
 - Increased market access - ability to meet customer/retailer needs
 - Increased implementation of food safety practices

Post Farm Food Safety Funding Model

Program Components

- Minimum 50% processor paid cost share
- Application-based, first come first served
- Delivered by Saskatchewan Agriculture

Post Farm Food Safety Components


1. Technical advice

A) Gap analysis – ID systems needs and costs

- max. \$1,200/processor prov. contribution

B) Program Development and Implementation

- Vendor recognition - max. \$3,250/processor prov. contribution OR
- HACCP/ISO 22000 - max. \$25,000/processor prov. contribution

Post Farm Food Safety Components cont'd.

2. First certification audits
 - A) Vendor Recognition Audit - max. \$1,200/processor prov. contribution OR
 - B) HACCP/ISO 22000 Audit - max. \$3,000/processor prov. contribution
3. Equipment
 - purchase of eligible equipment related to food safety testing or monitoring
 - max. \$1,200/processor prov. contribution
 - must be doing Vendor Recognition or HACCP/ISO 22000 to access this component
